Ohio Arts Council's Riffe Gallery to Present *Earthy Delights* 15 Contemporary Ohio Photographers Capture Earth's Curiosities

Columbus, Ohio —The Ohio Arts Council's Riffe Gallery presents *Earthy Delights*, an exhibition of contemporary photography by 15 Ohio artists, on view August 4 – October 9, 2016. Curated by Kenyon College Professor Marcella Hackbardt, *Earthy Delights* features Earth's varied textures and places, as well as imagery inspired by it. Artists' methods vary from traditional analog to digital; they utilize new tools like social media and virtual reality.

"Throughout the exhibition there are multiple references to human presence and needs, from footprints to shelter, and a responsibility to truly comprehend the notion that we are part of the Earth, an Earth that gives us life and delight," Hackbardt stated.

These artworks showcase a variety of photographic processes, employ great technical skill, and also explore relationships in their themes—particularly of humans and Earth.
